# **School Dress Code**

# **Purpose:**

• A uniform dress code reinforces in students a pride in their own appearance, instils recognition of themselves as an integral part of the school community, and assists in developing pride in representing their school. Issues of equality, health and safety, and expense are also factors which contribute to the establishment of the Dress Code.

### Aims:

- To promote equality amongst all students
- To further develop a sense of pride in, and identification with our school
- To provide durable clothing that is cost effective, practical and safe for our school environment
- To maintain and enhance the positive image of the school in the community

# **School wide expectations:**

- Our Lady of the Rosary has developed a Dress Code that we believe allows for students to safely engage in the many varied school activities and caters for the financial constraints of families
- The Dress Code applies during school hours, while travelling to and from school, and when students are on school excursions or representing the school in any way
- The School and Sports uniforms are prescribed, and are required to be worn
- Students should be exhibiting pride in their uniform
- School uniforms should be well cared for clean and free from wrinkles, rips and tears and should be of an appropriate size and fit.

# Other inclusions and exclusions as listed below:

**EARRINGS:** A maximum of 2 earrings per child i.e. one in each ear, are to be worn. Only a plain stud or small sleeper will be permitted. No other piercings are permitted.

**NECKLACES:** A Crucifix or religious type of necklace may be worn provided it is under the school uniform. No other necklaces will be permitted.

<u>WRIST WATCHES:</u> A wrist watch may be worn. Smart Watches may be worn if they are set to 'school mode' to ensure no access throughout the school day.

**NO** other jewellery other than the articles specified above will be permitted at any time.

**NAILS, NAIL POLISH and MAKEUP:** No acrylic/fake nails to be worn and no nail polish of any colour or type will be permitted. Makeup is also not allowed to worn to school.

<u>HAIR</u>: Any student, male or female, with hair over their face or eyes must have it clipped back by either a hair clip (navy blue or light blue) or by tying it back. Hair of shoulder length or longer, both male and female, must be worn tied back. Clipper cuts must be not less than a number 2, with no graphics or words etched into the cut. 'Rat Tails' and 'Mullet' style cuts are not considered an appropriate part of the school uniform.

<u>HAIR ACCESSORIES</u>: Plain blue (navy blue or light blue) ribbon, scrunchies and elastics will be permitted only. No flowers, coloured hair accessories etc will be permitted. Ribbons and bows should be of a reasonable size. Hair styles which restrict the effective wearing of the school hat will also not be permitted.

HAIR COLOUR: Hair colour should be natural.

**SHOES:** Black leather lace up, or Velcro school shoes. No joggers, boots, canvas or skate shoe style are permitted.

**SOCKS:** White anklet or quarter crew socks (no long style crew socks) are only permitted on Sports Days and must be plain white and only worn with the Sports Uniform. The school socks (sky blue for girls and navy blue for boys) should be worn on other days.

**SCHOOL SHIRTS**: All school shirts, girls and boys, are designed to be to be worn out, not tucked in.

**SPORTS SHIRTS**: On Sports Days only, Sports shirts to be worn out.

**BROKEN BAY JUMPERS:** These jumpers are considered merchandise and are optional for purchase. They are not part of the OLR school uniform. However, the students who have represented our OLR and Diocese may choose to wear them with their sport's uniform ONLY. They are not to worn by siblings or anyone other than the child for whom they were purchased.

#### **VARIATIONS TO THE UNIFORM:**

At times children may need to be without part of their official school uniform, including hat for genuine reasons. Should this occur we ask that you contact the teacher via Seesaw or send in a note. This would be acceptable for a short time while a replacement school article is purchased. Students who are not wearing the correct uniform may be approached by their class teacher or a member of the Leadership Team, as to the reason. If student's teacher had not been notified, they will be requested to make sure they are in the correct school uniform the next day. Parents will be notified if their child is not wearing the correct uniform. Additional uniform items can be obtained from the school uniform shop.
